We check the implementation of the quality policy and also of other policies through results of internal audits, satisfaction of clients and authorities along with the status of effectiveness of corrective and preventive actions, measures which are the outcome of the management reviews, changes that may affect the quality management system as well as the recommendations for improvement.

We are conscious that only a well trained and competent staff, with a practical experience is the key to an appropriate and effective performance of accreditation procedures. We'll organize continuous trainings for our staff (internal and external) as well as monitoring their effectiveness.

We have defined the objectives in order to fulfill the quality policies:

- Within the year 2017, all the corrective actions identified from the audits and assessments of foreign experts, must be undertaken.
- To obtain the opinions from its clients and regulatory authorities.
- To organize, within 2017 at least five internal training courses for increasing the level of knowledge relating to the accreditation.
- Develop 10 nos. of new conformity assessment bodies (preferably in Asia & Africa)
